Before You Go

Things to Pack

- Stroller covers – sun and rain
- Baby's hat
- Baby's sunglasses

- Baby's sunscreen
- Wipes
- Extra clothes
- Extra diapers
- Extra pacifiers
- Snacks, snacks, and more snacks
- Insulated lunchbox style cooler for breastmilk or formula (Yeti, RTIC , and Titan are great brands we've heard about. We have personally had great experiences with RTIC)
***DO NOT bring loose ice. You must use ice packs.
- Microfiber cloths for wet surfaces or hot babies (wet and cool them off)

Things Theme Parks Have

- Secure lockers for storing items
- Snacks – in case you run out or want something special
- FREE ice water (depending on the park)
- First Visit buttons (Disney parks)
- Certificates for our friends who are too small to ride an attraction. (These certificates give them the opportunity to ride during a future visit)
- Splash pads to burn energy and cool off
- Shows – these are great entertainment when you have a little one.
- Ride swap – for parents of little ones. Nobody has to miss out!
